Statement of the aim

Research Questions

Research method

- This research uses quantitative research. And collecting data using a questionnaire in this study.
- The population of this research was students in class VIII A and VIII B ICO (International Class Orientation) SMP Muhammadiyah 2 Taman in the 2023/2024 academic year, which consisted of 50 students.
- This research was conducted from January to February.
- The English teacher at the school recommended using ICO class VIII A and VIII B for this research.

Research Setting

- This research was conducted at SMP Muhammadiyah 2 Taman and used a questionnaire to collect data.
- Researchers distributed questionnaires to students.
- Then the researcher explained how to fill out the questionnaire before it was filled in by students.

Research Participant

- Population
 - In this research, the population used was the ICO (International Class Orientation) class, especially students in classes VIII A and VIII B of SMP Muhammadiyah 2 Taman in the 2023/2024 academic year.
- Sample
 - Researchers used two classes VIII A and VIII B ICO as many as 50 students for this study. Because this class was recommended by the teacher.

Instruments of The Research

- The instrument used in this research is using a questionnaire. The questionnaire is a list of questions given to other people who are willing to provide responses (respondents) according to user requests (Creswell, 2012).
- This questionnaire is in the form of a 26-item list of statements, the purpose of this questionnaire is to find out or measure students' interest in using role-playing techniques in speaking skills.

Data Collection

In this study, researchers collected data using a questionnaire instrument. Researchers distributed or distributed questionnaires conducted in class VIII A and VIII B ICO SMP Muhammadiyah 2 Taman. Which aims to determine or measure student interest in the use of role-play techniques in speaking skills. Thus, the results of this study were obtained from the answers of 50 students via the questionnaire that the researchers provided.

Data Analysis

After the data was collected, the next step was for the researcher to correct and calculate the resulting data from the answers to the questionnaires that had been filled in by the students. Researchers use a Likert scale to calculate the data.

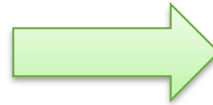

The picture above is the result of calculating the student's perception questionnaire. The first picture is the result of the score of each variable and the second picture is the result of the score of all variables.

The results of students' interest in using the role-play technique in speaking skills

After knowing the results of all variable scores, the researcher calculated the overall variable scores using the Likert scale formula, which aims to determine what percentage of students are interested in using roleplay techniques in speaking skills.

$$P = \frac{\text{Total Score}}{Y} \times 100$$

$$P = \frac{4939}{500} \times 100$$

$$P = 98,78$$

According to the results above, students' perceptions of the questionnaire reached 98.78% of the total. This shows that students have a positive attitude or can be called students interested in using role-playing techniques in their speaking skills.

Conclusion

This research revealed that many students were interested in using the role-play technique. Because of first, using role-play techniques can help students to build their confidence when speaking English. Second, using role-play techniques can provide students with various experiences that can be applied in the real world.
