Even if they have an account, they usually just use it for entertainment, in fact, social media, especially Instagram can be used for educational purposes; then if they don't understand about the feature, they can ask some friends that understand more about social media to be their mentor. The next researcher who wants to conduct similar research suggested doing more in-depth research on how the student perceived about benefits and problems in social media use for student English learning, For the future researchers may add other data collection like field observation, and also may add the number of participants for better research.
