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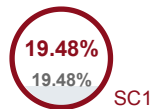
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Utilization of Globe Media to Improve the Learning Process

### 2. USE OF GLOBES IN THE TEACHING AND LEARNING PROCESS

#### 1. Information of the Globe

Appropriate learning media greatly **influences students' motivation in learning** in class. Alannasir [9] explains that if the learning process has utilized media, then it is hoped that students will be motivated to learn. Based on research, it is known that the use of media can provide encouragement to learn in order to improve learning outcomes. [10] One of them is Globe which is able to provide memory to students in memorizing world maps in Geography lessons and understanding English. This means that Globe has many benefits in student activities and greatly helps them in every aspect of life. [11]

#### 2. Procedures for Making a Globe as a Learning Medium

1. Paint a 30cm diameter styrofoam with light blue watercolor and let the paint dry.
2. Make a continent pattern on the soft foam and adjust the size of the image to the styrofoam.
3. Cut out the continent pattern, then paint the pattern and wait until it dries.
4. Draw a longitude on the styrofoam using black paint or marker.
5. Then stick the continent pattern on the styrofoam and adjust its position.
6. Write the names of the continents according to their location.
7. Attach the Globe to the handle.

#### 3. Steps to Use the Globe

1. Hold the Globe handle tightly using your left hand.
  2. Then lift it up to level with your left shoulder.
  3. Place the correct position of the globe (0o to 180o) the eastern hemisphere is on our right and (180o to 0o) the southern hemisphere is on our left standing.
  4. Rotate with just one finger (index finger) counterclockwise.
  5. Rotate slowly. If the Globe feels quite heavy, then just place it on the table for the same use as above.
3. CONCLUSION

Learning media has many benefits for the learning process, one of which is the Globe which is very useful in helping the Geography learning process to understand the world map in understanding English. Regarding the research findings, the author recommends educators, learners, and subsequent researchers to study more deeply about Globe media to facilitate the teaching and learning process. The media is able to attract students' interest to be more diligent in studying Geography lessons in English comprehension.
