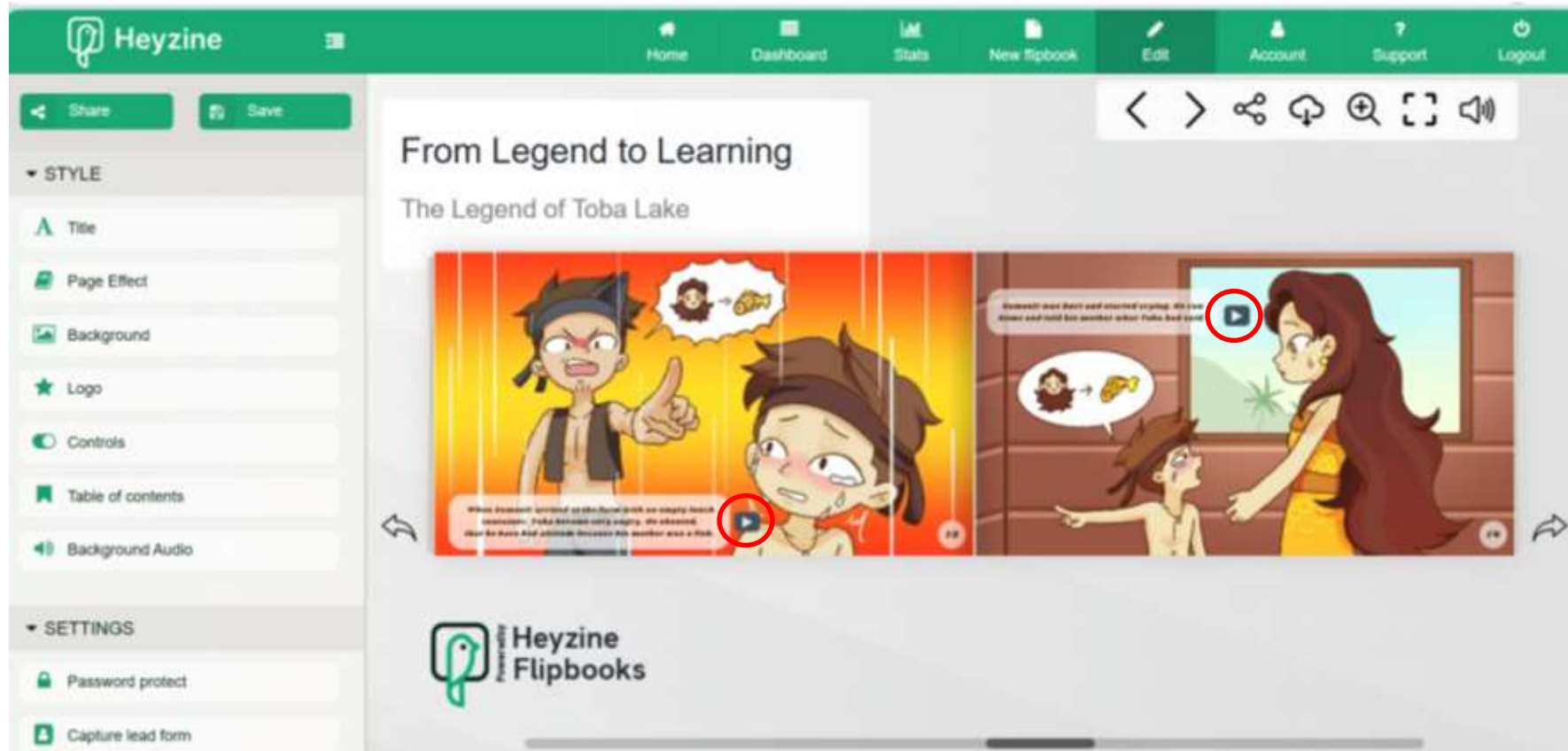
# How to use

WORD	MEANING
Farmer	A person who grows plants or raises animals for a living.
Fishing rod	A long stick used for catching fish.

Harvest	To collect crops or vegetables from a farm.
Spoiled	Treated too kindly or given too much, often lead to bad behavior.
Flood	A large amount of water that covers land.
Storm	Bad weather with strong wind, rain, and sometimes thunder.
