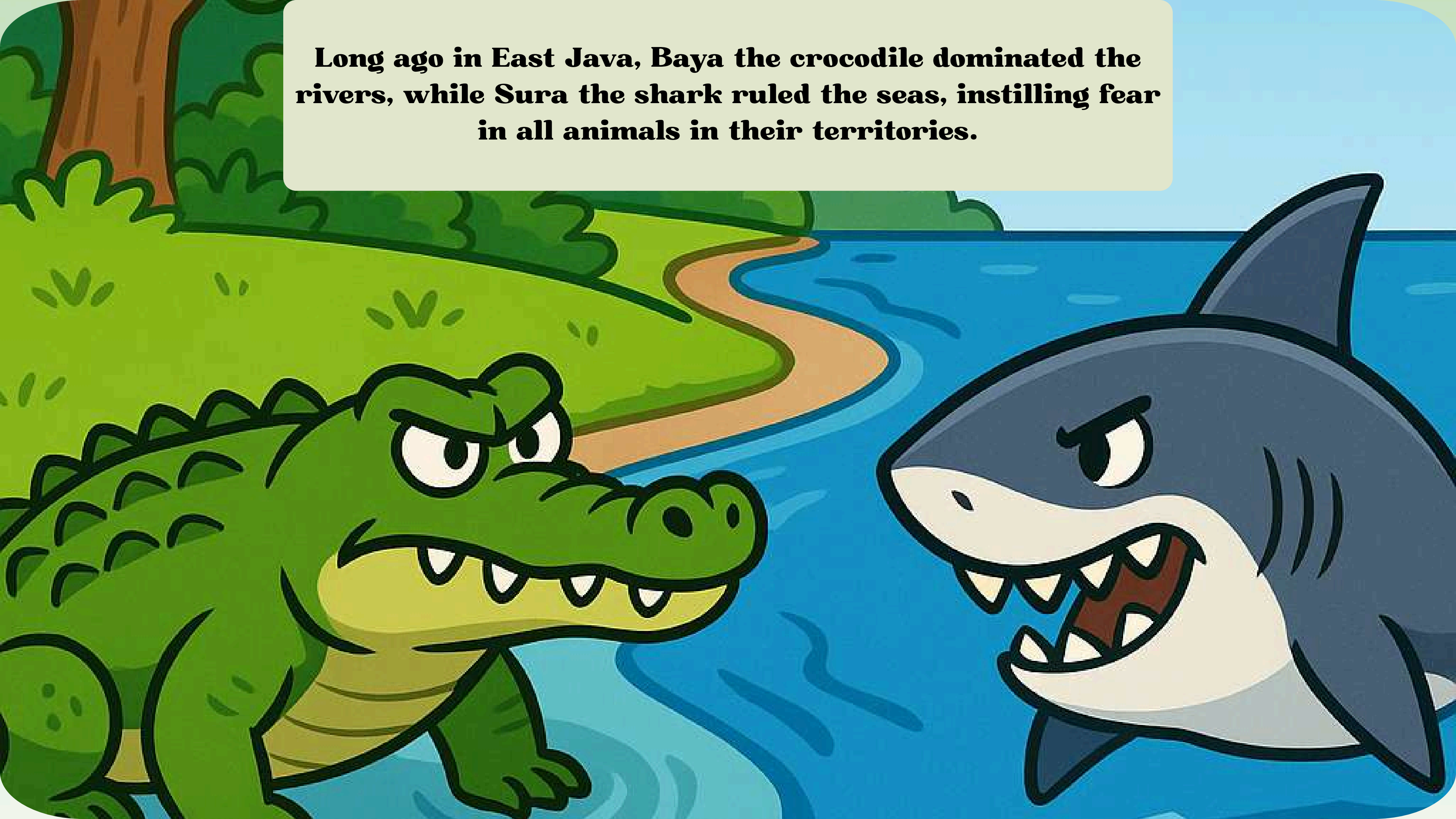


THE HISTORY OF SURABAYA



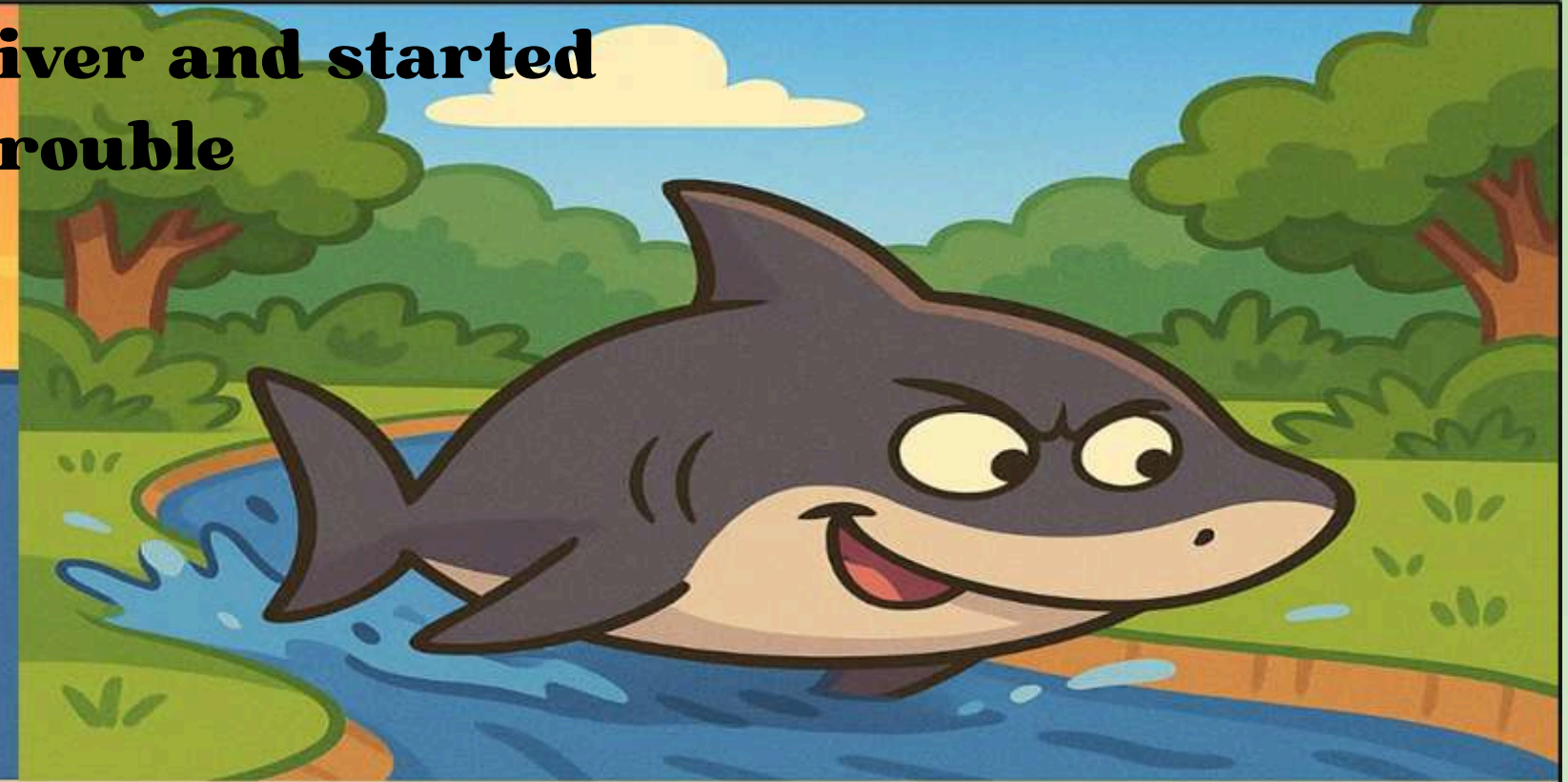
Long ago in East Java, Baya the crocodile dominated the rivers, while Sura the shark ruled the seas, instilling fear in all animals in their territories.



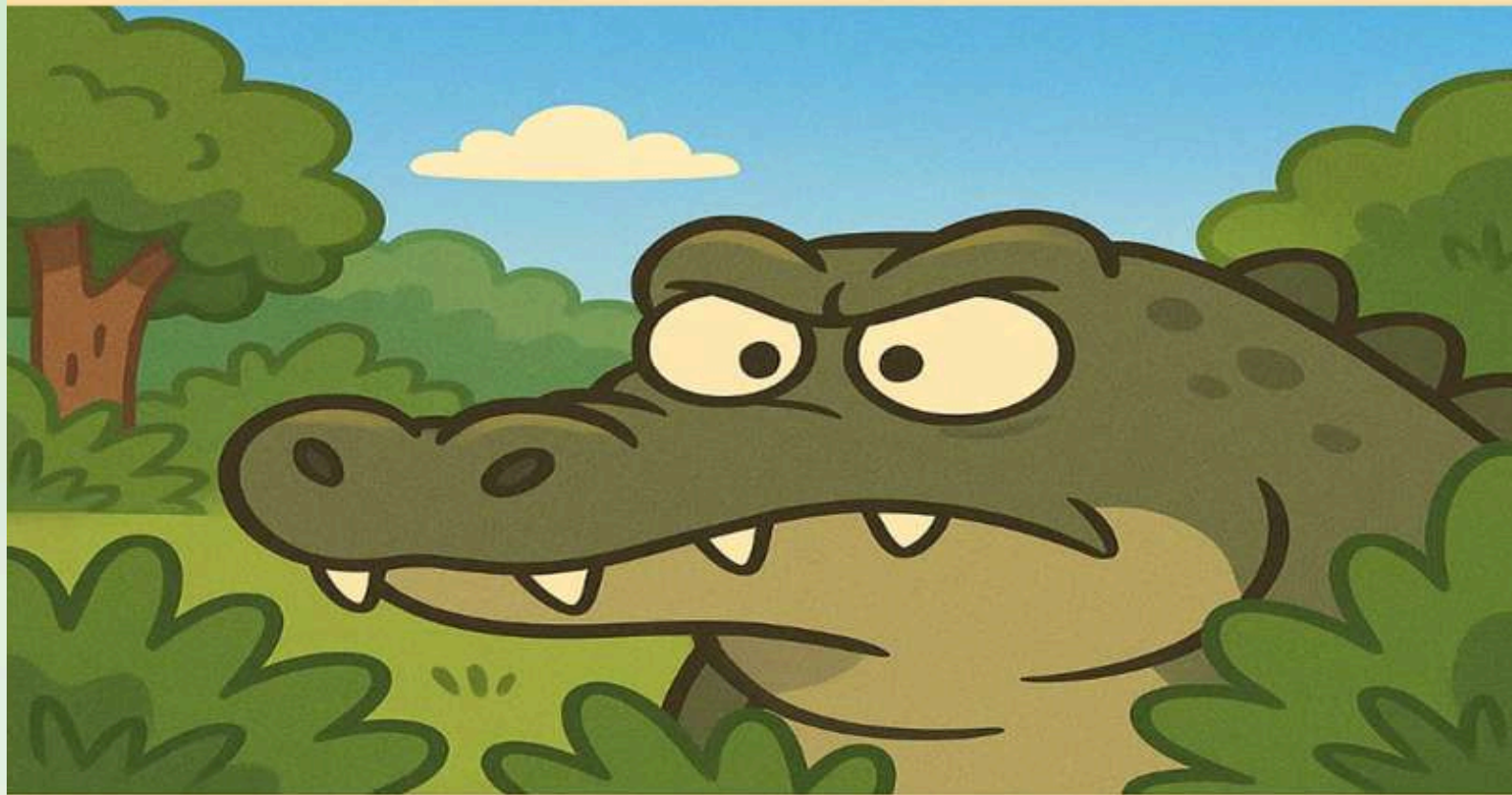
**Sura entered the river and started

Baya finds Sura devouring a fawn.

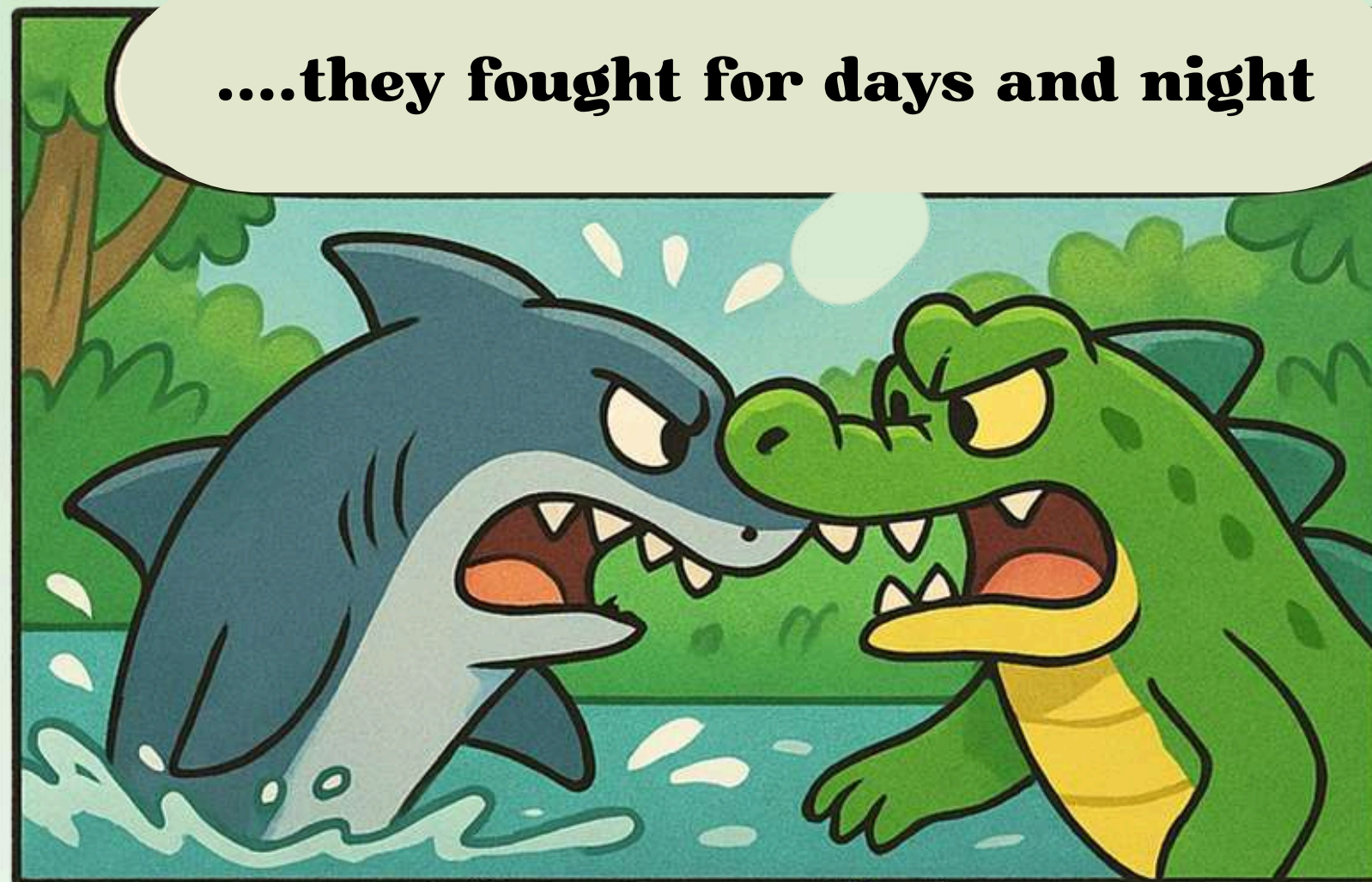
**what are you doing in my
river, Sura?**



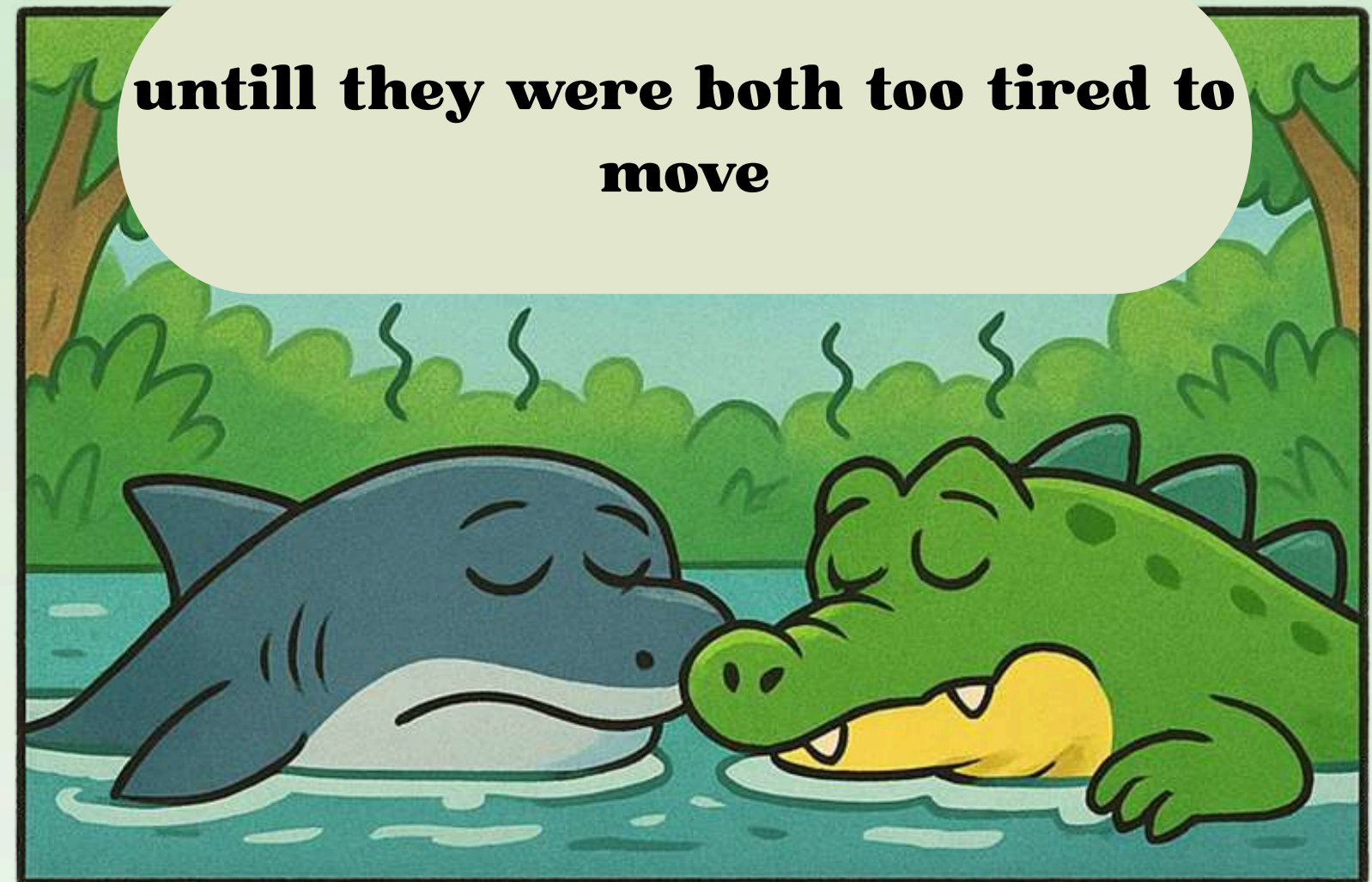
**this river has more

....they fought for days and night



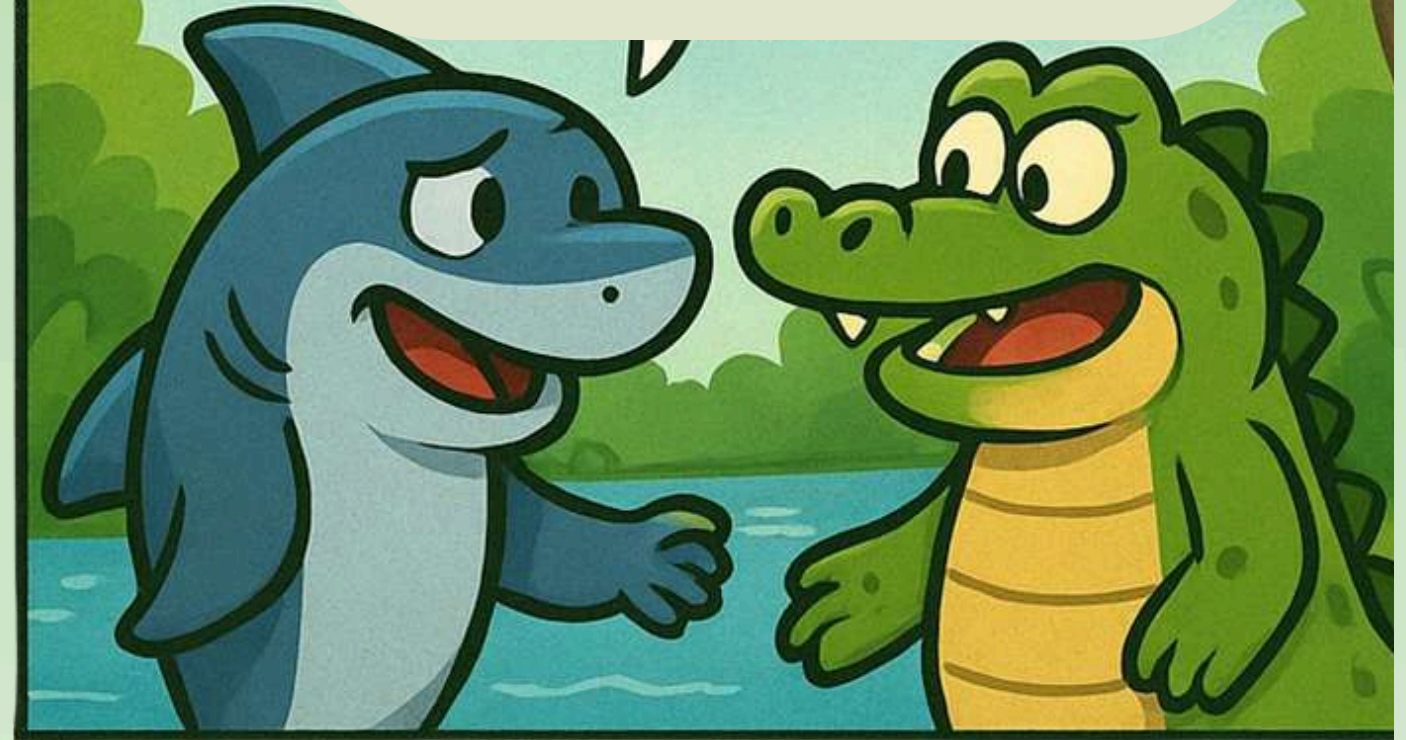
**untill they were both too tired to

forever...**



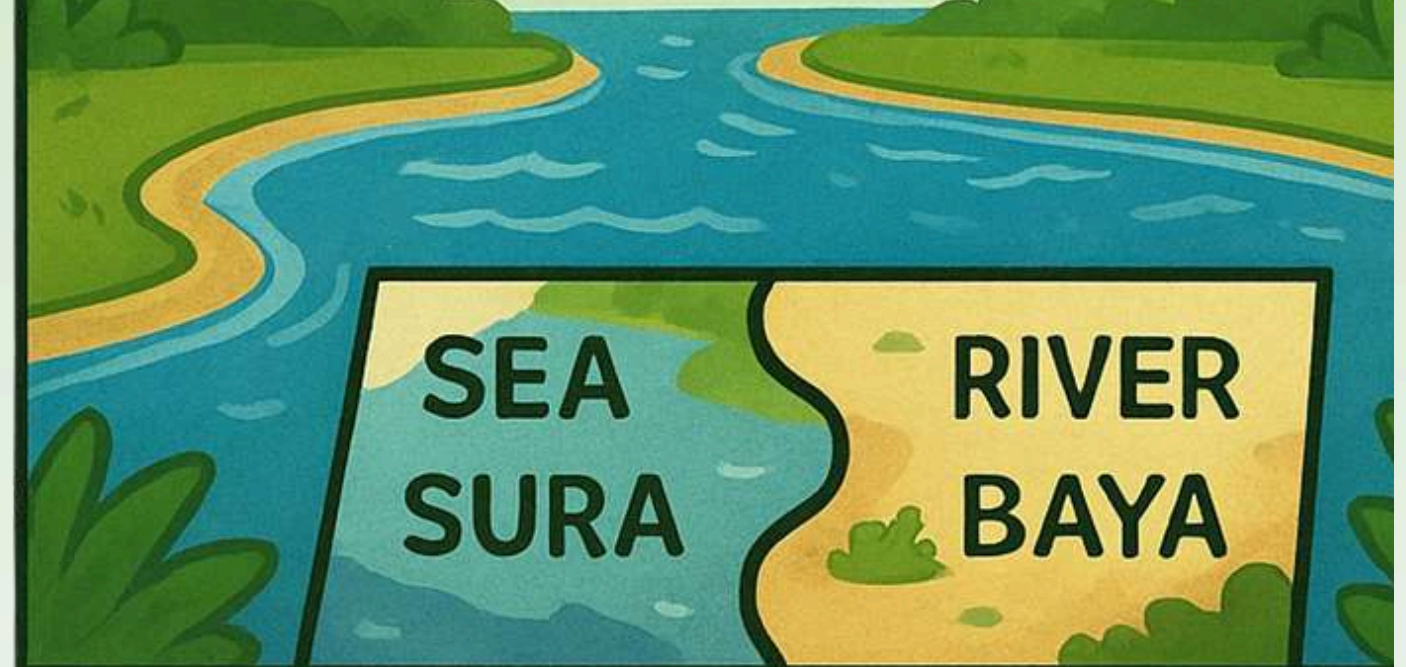
Let's make a deal

was set.**



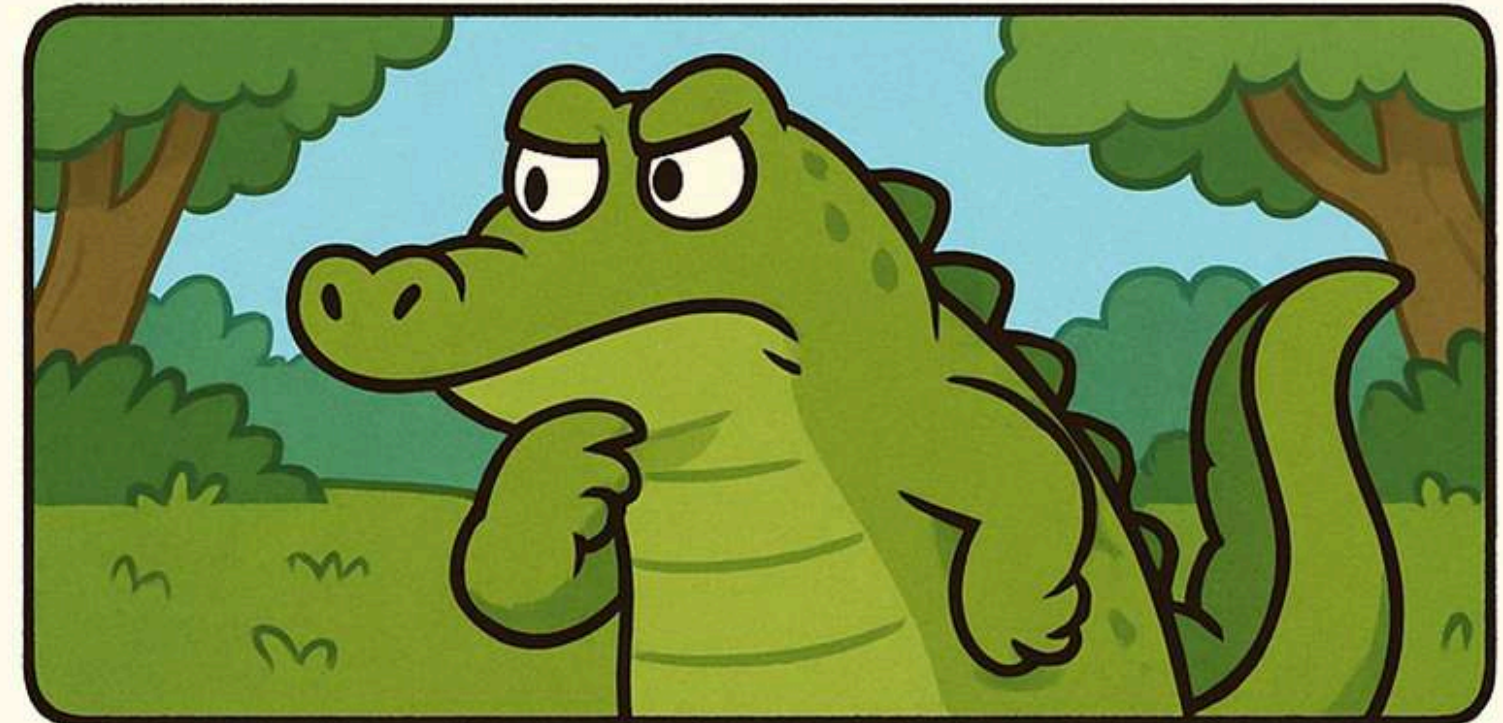
No one will notice if I sneak into the river

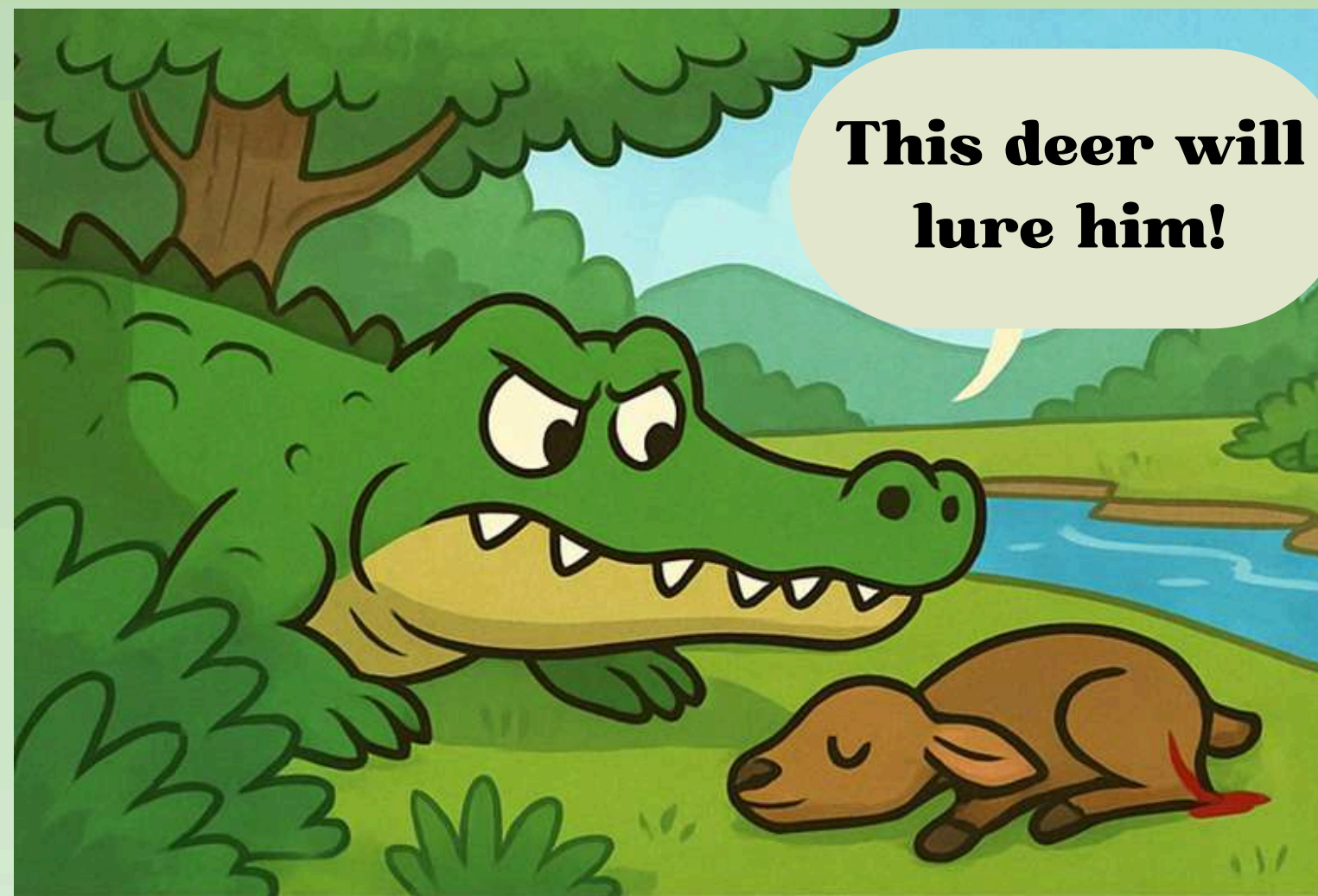


**Sura hunted again,
